Our continuous improvement efforts involve constant analysis of our entire value chain - from the acquisition of raw materials to the delivery of the final product to consumers.

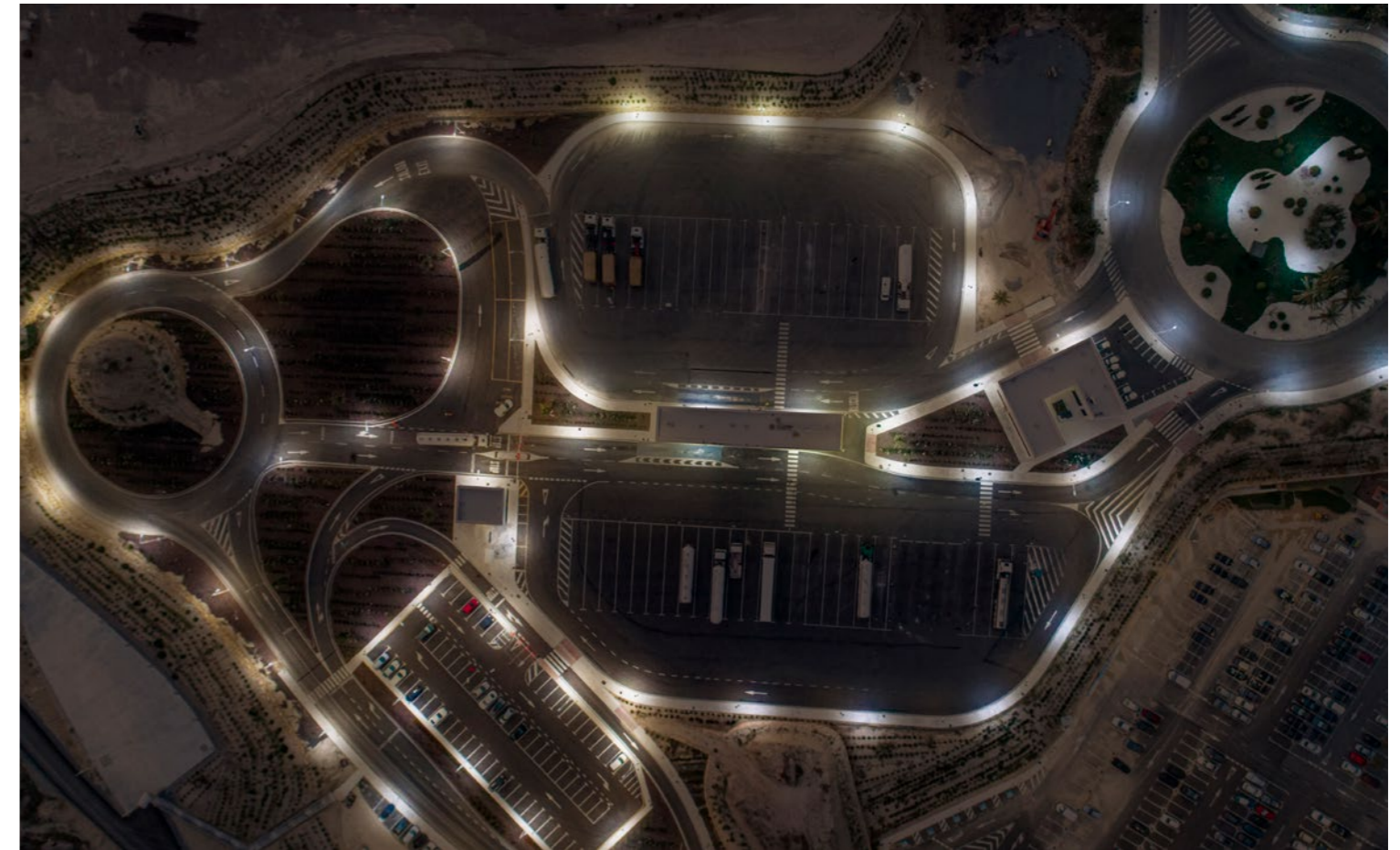

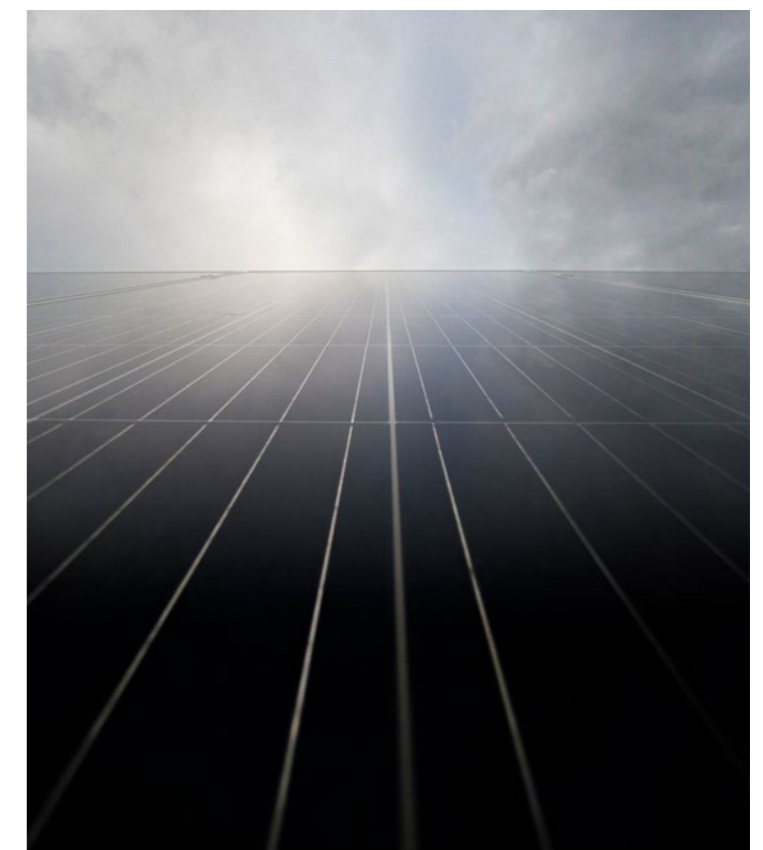

Energy

Energy efficiency and the use of renewable energy sources are the two key elements of our strategy to minimize environmental impact.

100% of our energy consumption comes from renewable energy sources.

On the other hand, the constant improvement of our processes and machinery allows us to reach high levels of energy efficiency, which translates to an 8% decrease of our electrical consumption in our production processes.

Water

Since our inception, we have valued the importance and understood the challenges of proper water management.

It has motivated us to implement a sustainable use policy maximizing the efficient use of water resources in the different production processes.

We use cutting-edge technology to achieve 99% recycled water in all our processes in the Cosentino Industrial Park.

In addition, we use 100% of the surplus water to irrigate green areas.

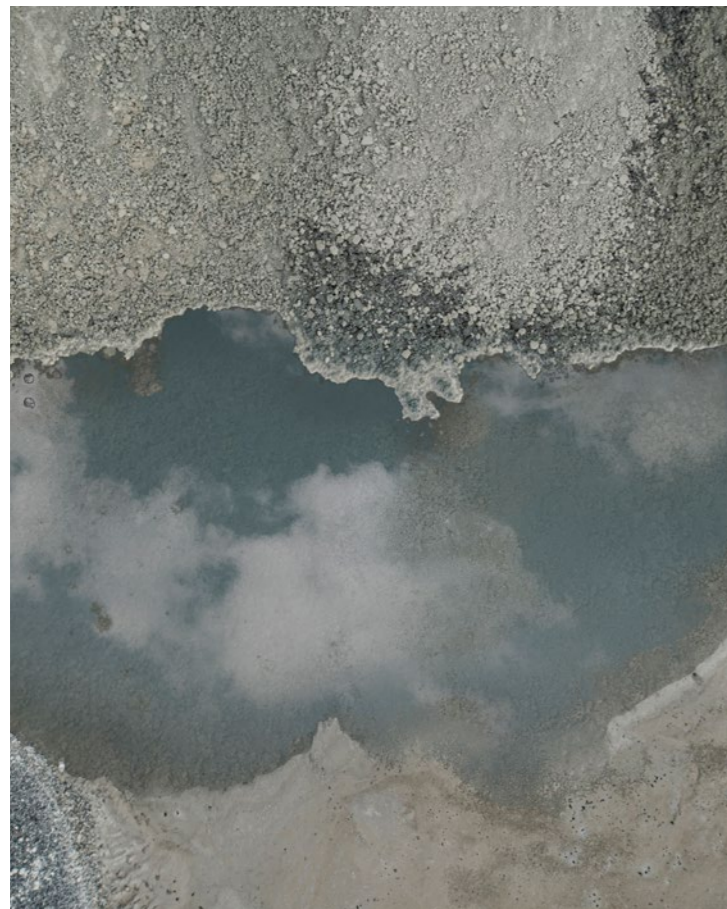


Materials

We are committed to making the most of the materials we work with throughout the value chain.

In recent years we embarked on an ambitious R&D project called "Circularity" to reuse the materials from which we make our products.

Another action is the disruptive Hybriq+® technology that brings about the new generation of Silestone. Hybriq+® incorporates a minimum of 20% recycled materials and is manufactured with 100% renewable energy and 99% recycled water.



Carbon neutrality: Sustainable design



Sustainable development is an essential commitment in Cosentino's growth strategy, prioritizing environmental protection and preservation.

To make sustainable use of natural resources and protect biodiversity and ecosystems, we address specific aspects related to the efficient use of resources, proper waste management, atmospheric emissions, and more.

Cosentino is committed to the United Nations' 2030 agenda and the Local Action Plan promoted by the Spanish government.

We have managed to offset 42,532 tons of CO₂ emissions resulting from one year of Dekton production, thus obtaining the Zero Carbon Footprint label in 2019 for the entire lifecycle of all Dekton products.

Additionally, the Sunlit Days collection is Silestone's first collection to achieve carbon neutrality.



We reduce our impact

We are committed to energy efficiency, emissions reduction and sustainable mobility to minimize our impact.

- **Energy efficiency:** It is a priority to reduce energy consumption in the production processes and Cosentino's general activities. 100% of the electricity used comes from renewable sources.
- **Emission reduction:** 2.8 million Euros have been invested to implement energy management and monitoring systems which allows the heat from Dekton's furnaces to be recovered and used in dryers, resulting in reduced emissions.



We calculate our carbon footprint

An external body verifies the calculation and results of the carbon footprint data submitted to the Spanish Ministry for Ecological Transition and Demographic Challenge (MITECO, in Spanish) which is responsible for approving and registering our footprint, becoming part of the 'Spanish registry of carbon footprint, offsetting and carbon dioxide absorption projects' of the Spanish Climate Change Office (OECC, in Spanish), who publishes the results in an exercise of transparency.

This calculation uses energy and/or fuel consumption data, as well as raw material consumption data collected from all **Group subsidiaries** (Centers, Workshops, Cities, HUBs, HQ, etc.) with the goal of offset these emissions.

CO2 NEUTRAL

We offset our emissions

To achieve carbon neutrality in Dekton, **we offset our emissions over the entire product life cycle** (scopes 1+2+3) by investing in GHG emission reduction projects.

We identify those projects that meet the requirements for responsible offsetting and that, in turn, have a strong social dimension that contribute to the achievement of the **Sustainable Development Goals of the UN's 2030 Agenda**.

The project selected to offset the 42,532 tons of CO₂ emissions, resulting from one year of Dekton production, has a direct impact on sustainable development by **supporting the local economy, providing training and job opportunities**.

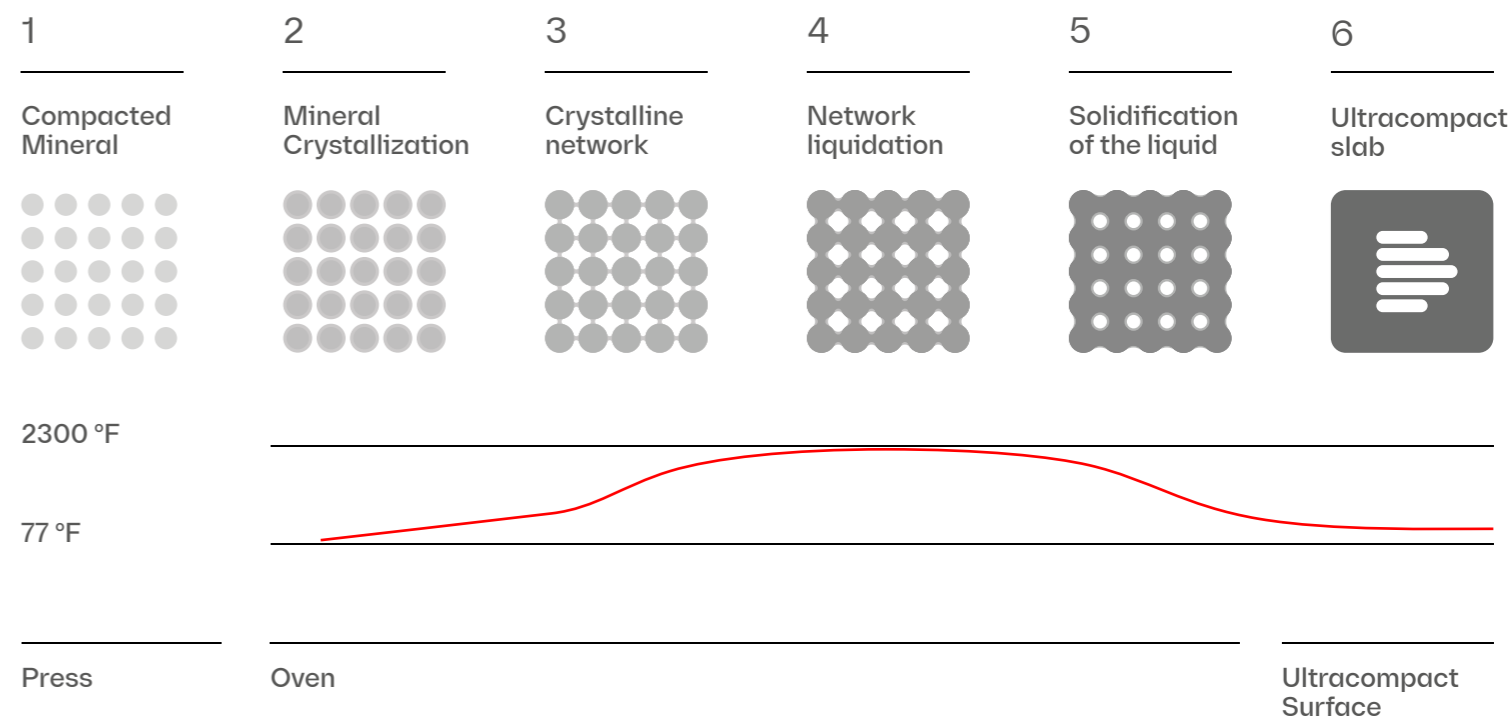
Sintered Particle Technology

Dekton uses an exclusive sintered particle technology (SPT) which sinters mineral particles, bonding and compacting their internal structure. This innovative technological process mimics and accelerates the process natural stone undergoes when exposed to high pressure and temperatures for millenia.

- The furnace has a length of 180 meters (590 ft).
- Temperatures reach approximately 2300°F
- Total processing time depends on the thickness of the slab (about 4 hours).

Safety in facades and cladding

In order to reinforce safety in ventilated facades and interior cladding, there is the possibility of adhering a safety mesh behind the Dekton slab, specially developed to prevent falls due to breakage. It is a 300 g/m² fiberglass mesh adhered to the material with epoxy resin.



Dekton Product features

Dekton meets all the technical specifications required in a high-resistance surface to materialize any interior and exterior residential design project.



Low water absorption

The water absorption of Dekton is negligible; therefore, it does not undergo expansion movements.



High resistance to UV rays

Dekton is highly resistant to ultraviolet light (UV rays) and will not fade or degrade over time in any indoor or outdoor application.



Superior mechanical strength

The wide variety of Dekton thicknesses allows its use in applications where a high wind or impact resistance are a requirement.



Fireproof material

Dekton can withstand the highest temperatures without burning, charring, or cracking. The standard European tests EN 13501 y ASTM E84 qualify the ultracompact surface as non-combustible.



Durable Color

The control of pigmentation and decoration in the manufacturing process of Dekton gives the material better color uniformity for each slab, resulting in a long-lasting product that does not fade over time.



Resistant to scratches

Dekton is one of the most scratch resistant surfaces on the market today. It has a rating of seven (7/10) on the Mohs scale of mineral hardness.



Dimensional stability

The expansion of Dekton is minimal: the panels can be installed with thin joints. These joints will retain their width under all conditions.



Freeze and thaw resistance

The resistance that Dekton has demonstrated in durability tests under freezing and thawing situations in various conditions proves its high performance.



Abrasion resistance

Dekton is even more resistant to abrasion than granite and porcelain, being the ideal surface for facades or floors subjected to high activity in commercial applications.



Maximum fire and heat resistance

Dekton has been successfully installed in facades located in areas exposed to high temperatures.



Easy cleaning and minimal maintenance

Dekton's durability greatly minimizes maintenance costs. Even graffiti can be removed from Dekton with standard cleaning products.

Its contemporary design, by Enrique Romero from ZET Arquitectos, stands out in its surroundings while establishing a balanced dialogue with the landscape. 'Integration with the surroundings and the topography provides the basis for generating the forms and spaces,' explains the architect. 'The result is a geometry based on vertices that produce seemingly suspended volumes,' he continues.

The facade of the house has a very strong aesthetic appeal, to which Dekton contributes as the main material. Inside, the design team selected other Dekton colours to give character to the rooms, which retain a taste for geometric shapes as seen on the outside.

'We chose Dekton because it is lightweight and easy to adapt to the shapes generated in the project,' says the architect. The versatility of Dekton makes it possible to combine two facade systems: a ventilated facade, featuring 4 mm Dekton panels glued on profiles with a certified adhesive system using cleaner, adhesion promoter,

double-sided tape and adhesive line; and a glued facade, featuring 8 mm Dekton panels on a continuous substrate with cement-based adhesive. In both cases, the fixing is concealed and allows the facade planes to be continuous, interrupted only by the joint between panels of up to a maximum of 3.20 x 1.44 m. This type of fixing is common in residential projects where the facade starts from the ground floor and is highly visible at close range.

Its sinuous curves cut across the horizon, blending in perfectly with the Mediterranean landscape and paying homage to the light of the Costa del Sol. The architectural design is also fully adapted to the unevenness of the site, with the main house and an annex forming a single unit. The focal point is a large horizontal hall that articulates the spaces and adapts to the topography.





The colour of choice for the facade, which was installed using an adhesive system, was Dekton Aeris. This is a light shade with cream details inspired by white limestone, which blends in perfectly with the landscape and its surroundings.
